Dear Friends,

Once again we would like to welcome you to north Wales. It is 14 years since we last held a RHM meet at this international venue. There is a wide variety of climbing on many superb crags of excellent quality. Most of the climbs are between 2 and 4 pitches requiring double ropes. Most routes provide very good protection using nuts and friends. The inland crags are mainly on volcanic rock with many having short walk in but some mountain crags are up to 1.5 hours walk. There are also world renowned sea cliffs at Gogarth. Bolted routes exist in the slate quarries and on limestone but these are in the minority. There are also excellent opportunities for walking and scrambling in this very picturesque area with peaks of up 1,000m.

### **What to bring**

Single 9mm 50m rope.

All UK participants will have a full rack, but if you have traditional gear then please bring it.

We have arranged a visit to a climbing equipment factory DMM on Monday where it will be possible to purchase gear at discounted prices.

Don't forget warm clothes and waterproofs, but pray for unlimited sunshine.

### **Arrival**

- Air - A variety of airlines offer cheap flights to the UK, Ryan air, easy jet. Most accessible airport to venue being Manchester or Liverpool.
- Train – from Manchester airport to Picadilly station to Llandudno Junction, change to Betws-y coed, where we will pick you up there or it maybe possible pick-up can be arranged from the airports.
- Car – Drive to North Wales and follow local map on next sheet.
- From the south M6 onto the A5 towards Bangor @ capel curig follow local map  
From the north M6 / M56 to north wales on the A55 towards Bangor  
follow A5 south @ capel curig follow local map
