A SHORT GEOGRAPHICAL INTRODUCTION

Festival. Part 1. "Opening". Urals.

The Urals is a peculiar mountain region. There are many wild places – rocks, lakes, forests and mountains – which are very interesting for rock climbers, mountaineers and tourists.

There are many fantastic granite rock faces with vertical and overhanging walls in the Middle Urals, for example Shikhan, Seven Brothers.

The height of the rock faces is 30-50 m. There are many routes (from very easy to very difficult) at the granite massifs and it therefore is of interest to beginners as well as advanced rock climbers.

The first part of our Festival will be at the rocks of «Shikhan»

Festival. Part 2. Climbing in the National Park “Stolby”. Krasnoyarsk. Siberia.

Another very interesting and widely known climbing region is a state national park “*Stolby*” (*Rock pillars*). It is located in Siberia near Krasnoyarsk city. This is the forest area with picturesque rocks of rose granite towering like castles above the “Siberian taiga”.

The height of rock faces is 30-200 m. There are many rock pillars with very interesting names including “*Perja*” (*Feathers*), “*Ded*”(Grandfather),” *Perviy Stolb*” (*The first rock pillar*) and etc. Here local climbers use the unique unusual style of climbing - “Krasnoyarsk stolbism”. There are many different routes which are free climbed as well as the routes equipped with bolts (from 5 to 7c on French classification).

Festival. Part 3. Eastern Sayan. The lake Baikal.

Tunkinskie Goltzy is the most eastern mountain ridge of the Big mountain country “Eastern Sayan” near the south end of the Great Baikal Lake. Tunkinskie Goltzy extend from west to east for about 300 km. The highest peak of the ridge is the mountain “Munku- Sardik” (3511 m). There are no any glaciers and big snow slopes in the summer.

All peaks of the Tunkinskie Goltzy have the rock type of the mountain relief. There are different routes (from 1st to 5th categories of difficulty on Russian classification). The nearest settlement to the region of mountaineering is the village “Arshan”.

There are:

- 1) The rescue service

- 2) The guides who know the region very well.
- 3) Professional doctors, medicine chest
- 4) The stable mobile phone connection
- 5) Detailed descriptions of different routes to the tops of the local mountains

We will do the ascents to the classified alpinist routes with guides of Irkutsk Mountain Federation.

The festival will be for those who like rock climbing, adventures and nature.

Attention please ! Participants, who are interested in rock climbing only, can take place in the 2 first parts of the Festival (The Urals and “Stolby”). In another case, those who want to ascent to Tunkinskie Goltzy peaks (without the Urals and “Stolby”) can do it in the third part of the Festival.

According to the first variant the dates of Festival will be from 08 to 19 of July. Arrival to Yekaterinburg. Departure from Krasnoyarsk.

As to the second variant, the dates will be from 21 July to 03 August. Arrival to Irkutsk and departure from Irkutsk too. There is the International airport in Irkutsk.

Price for both the first variant and the second variant is 250 euro.

According to these two variants participants must have suitable equipment.

* Information about travel to Yekaterinburg or Irkutsk (we shall define this information more exactly in April 2012)

- 1) the direct flight from your big city to Yekaterinburg or Irkutsk (there are the International airports in Yekaterinburg and Irkutsk). The cost of plane one-way ticket (for example from Zurich to Yekaterinburg) is from 120 to 220 euro (Aeroflot Company).
- 2) the flight from your city to Moscow and then from Moscow to Yekaterinburg or Irkutsk (3 flights every day). The cost of plane one-way ticket from Moscow to Yekaterinburg is from 40 to 100 euro (Aeroflot Company).
- 3) by train from Moscow to Yekaterinburg (~ 26 hours). The cost of train one-way ticket from Moscow to Yekaterinburg is from 35 to 130 euro.

- Date: 08 July – 02 August 2012
- Place: The rocks area "Shikhan" (near Yekaterinburg), the rocks in the National Park "Stolby" (Near Krasnoyarsk), Tunkinskie Goltzy (Eastern Sayan), Baikal lake, Russia
- Participants: Ages 18-25 years old. Participants younger than 18 should be accompanied by a federation team leader who is over 18. Highest possible number of foreign participants is about 20 persons. It is compulsory to have a vaccination against the encephalitic tick.
- Highlights: "School of the beginning rock climbers", rock climbing, training, mountaineering, ecological actions, songs, excursions, meeting friends
- Accommodation: Tents
- Meals: Full board
- Transfers: By bus, by train, on foot according to the program
- Guides: Guides of the children's Olympic Reserve School of Mountaineering Sports of Yekaterinburg, local guides from Irkutsk and Angarsk.
- Equipment: the list of equipment is attached
- Arrival: 07 July. Participants will be met by representatives of the organizing committee at the airport Koltsovo or at the railway station of Yekaterinburg (Sverdlovsk).
- Departure: 02 August from Slyudyanka (near Baikal lake)
- Price for the whole program: 350 euro
- The transport expenses from Yekaterinburg to Krasnoyarsk and from Krasnoyarsk to Slyudyanka are involved in the price of the Festival
- The travel expenses to Yekaterinburg (like any travels before start and finish of Festival) and back will have to be paid by the participants (or their federations).**

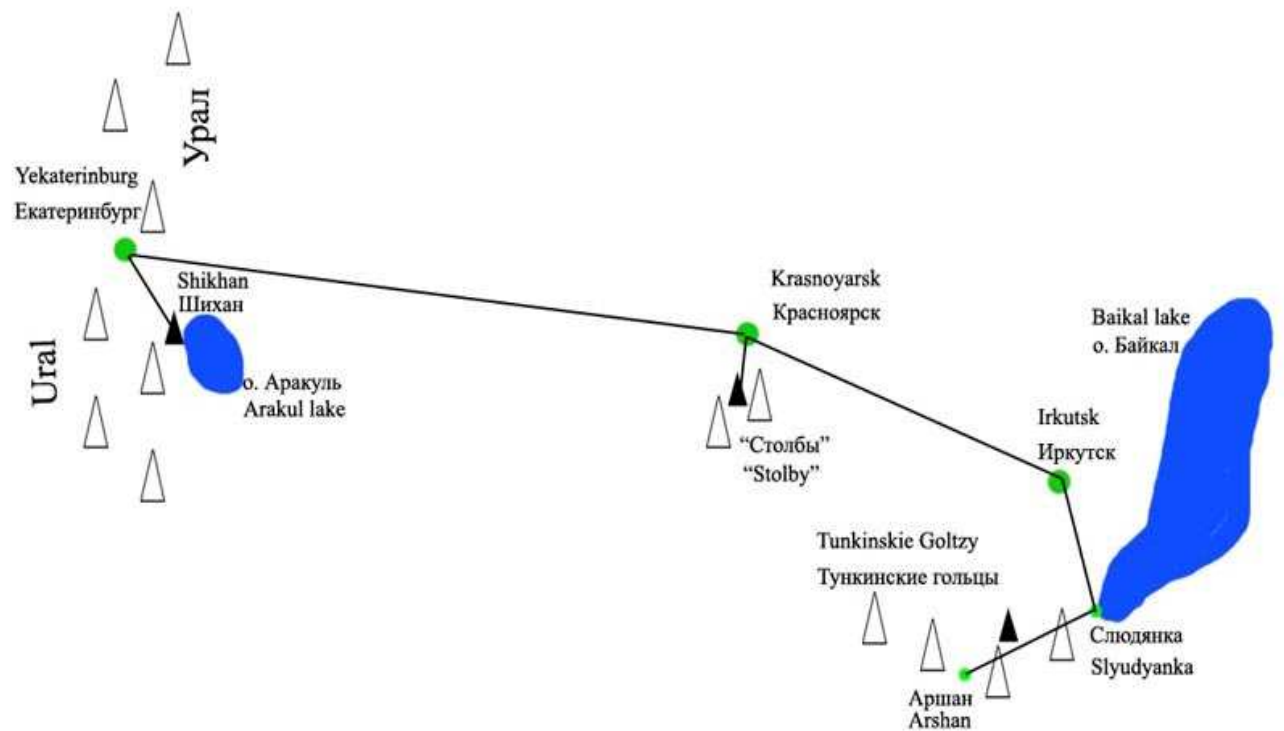

Festival Program

July 08	Official opening of the Festival in Yekaterinburg on the border of two continents – Europe and Asia.
July 09	Transfer to the rocks area "Shikhan" by bus and on foot (4 km). The tent camp organizing. Opening of school of the beginning rock-climber and alpinist, climbing on the rocks. Individual training on the routes of different difficulty. In the evening: supper, acquaintance with the Ural nature and people.
July 10	Opening of the practical course “Skills of safety during the rock climbing”. Climbing in pairs on the routes of different difficulty. Individual training on the routes of different difficulty.
July 11	The ecological action. Friendly bouldering competitions. The songs of different countries near the camp fire.
July 12	Transfer to Yekaterinburg by bus. The cultural program in Yekaterinburg. In the evening - arrival to Krasnoyarsk.
July 13	Transfer from Yekaterinburg to Krasnoyarsk by train.
July 14	Arrival to Krasnoyarsk. Transfer to the rock massif Takmak by bus. Accommodation in the refugee near the rock massif. Ascent to the highest point of Takmak. In the evening – Russian banya (sauna).
July 15	Transfer to another rock massif Kitaika. Individual training on the routes of different difficulty.
July 16	Transfer to the central Stolby by bus. Tent camp organizing. Ascent to the First Pillar (“Pervii Stolb”), bouldering. Excursion to the zoo of Stolby.
July 17	Hike to the refuge “Grify” (12 km). Climbing on the Grify’s rocks.
July 18	Return to the base camp. Climbing on the central Stolby.
July 19	Transfer to Krasnoyarsk. Cultural program in the city. In the evening – departure to Slyudyanka by train.
July 21	Arrival to Slyudyanka. Transfer to Arshan by bus (130 km).
July 22	Transfer to Handagai gorge (5 hours on foot). Base camp organizing.
July 23	Acclimatization hike to the high mountain zone. Training of the belying and climbing on the local rocks. In the evening: funny competitions and songs at the camp fire
July 24	Ascent to the top of peak Arshan (2546 m).
July 25	Rest in the base camp.
July 26	Ascent to the top of peak Arshan (2546 m) in another way.
July 27	Rest in the base camp.
July 28	Ascent to the top of peak Baruun (3260 m).
July 29	Reserve day in the case of the bad weather
July 30	Transfer to Arshan and then to Slyudyanka. Trasfer from Slyudyanka to port Baikal and then to the village Angasolka on the lakeside of Baikal. Tent camp.

July 31	Excursion along the lakeside of Baikal. Climbing on the local rocks.
August 01	Rest on the lakeside of Baikal. Farewell party. Solemn closing of festival
August 02	Departure to Yekaterinburg or to Irkutsk by train

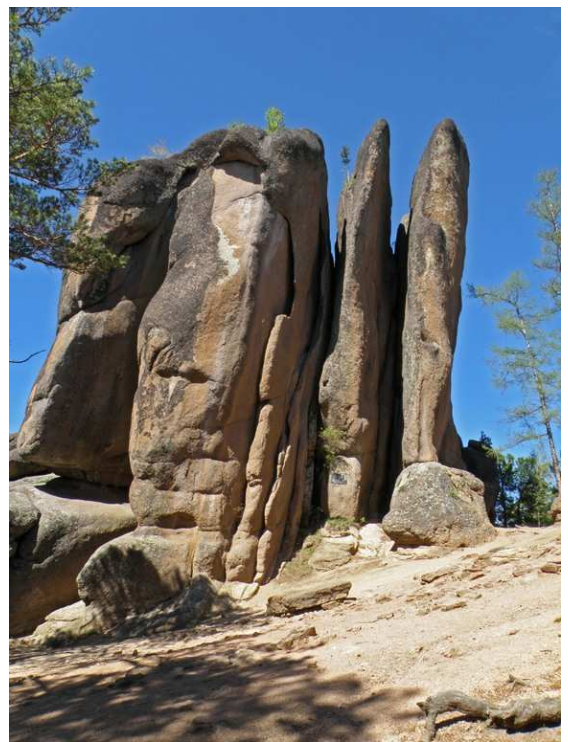
Scheme of place of the Festival



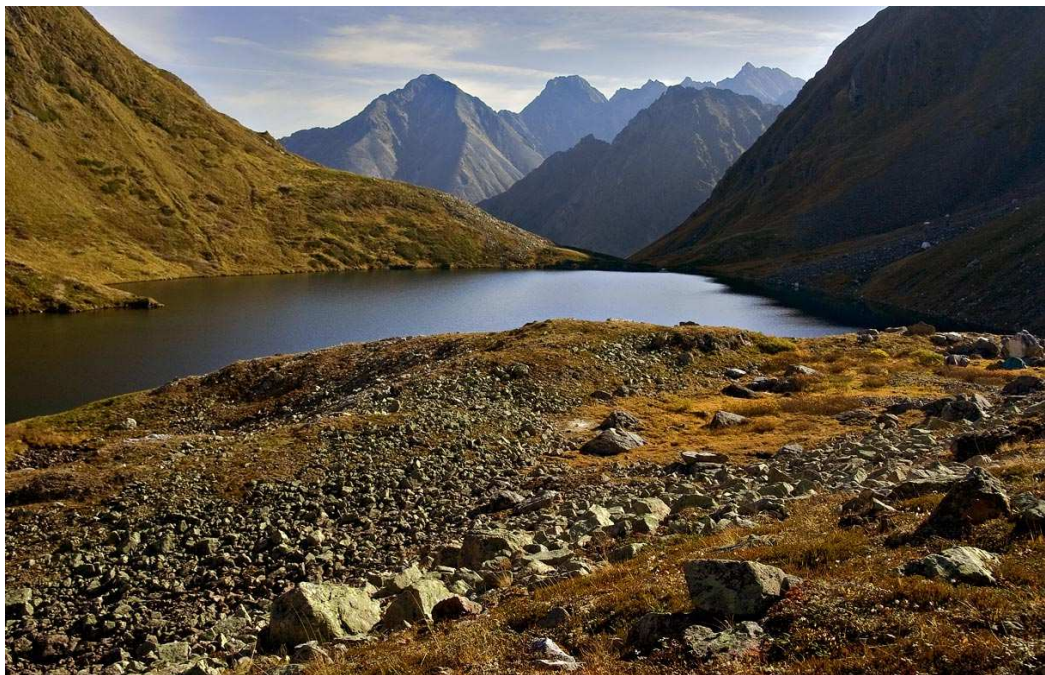
Tunkinskie Goltzy
