

## **Tokyo 2020 Qualification**



Sport Climbing made its first appearance in an Olympic context in October at the Youth Olympic Games in Buenos Aires, and the climb to the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020 continues. In 2019 and 2020, the Tokyo 2020 qualification events for Sport Climbing will take place at world-class Combined events around the globe.

An even 20 men and 20 women will become the first Olympians of Sport Climbing next year. The top 7 men and women athletes in the Combined finals of the IFSC World Championships in Tokyo will qualify to climb in the Combined format of Tokyo 2020, 6 men and women will join them from the first ever Olympic Qualifying Event for Sport Climbing in Toulouse, and 5 men and women will qualify through their respective Combined Continental Championships in Africa, Asia, Europe, Oceania and PanAmerica. The remaining athletes will be chosen by the host country of Japan (1+1) and the Tripartite Commission (1+1). A maximum of 2 men and 2 women may qualify per country.
