Young Sport Climbers will train in Žilina (Slovakia)

In a few days, 15.-18. February 2019, athletes from Czechia, Hungary, Poland and Slovakia will join V4 Youth Olympic Climbing Camp 2019.

These young climbers will take part in training and competition simulation of all three climbing disciplines. Bouldering, lead and speed climbing. In this combination of disciplines sport climbing introduces the Olympics. For the first time in the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020.

The camp is organized by Climbing Academy from Modra (SVK) and is financially supported by Visegrad Fund. Similar camp took place in Bratislava in 2017 ([video](#)). The upcoming camp will take place in newly built climbing gym La Skala in Žilina (SVK). Bouldering and lead parts will be run by Vilda Chejn (CZE) and Dávid Závacký (SVK), speed by Polish partners.
