PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All participating athletes, officials and organising staff must submit a negative COVID-19 real-time-PCR test (taken no more than 72 hours prior to the arrival day) to the COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor, Lea Kistler at **lea.kistler@bluewin.ch** upon arrival/registration at the event.

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country.

The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDANCE (as per the Addendum to IFSC Rules)

Participation of all Team Members shall be confirmed upon arrival to location to the IFSC Technical Delegate by phone or via email in the 24 hours period between **11:59 PM (UTC +1) of April 14** and **11:59 PM (UTC +1) of April 15**.

Confirmation of attendance and COVID-rapid-antigen-testing on site



RESPONSE PROTOCOL IN CASE OF POSITIVE RAPID TEST

In case of a positive rapid test result, the participation at the event will be not permitted.

Procedures on isolation will be carried out according to Swiss National Guidelines .

Procedures as per 17 February 2021:

- In case of a positive result from a rapid test, a PCR test will be mandatory. COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor will manage each situation.
- People who have tested positive after a PCR test, must go into isolation. Isolation normally lasts 10 days. <u>COVID-19: Instructions on Isolation</u>
- People with symptoms of infection with the coronavirus must go into quarantine for ten days (subject to certain requirements it is possible to shorten this period). <u>COVID-19: Instructions on quarantine</u>
- Location of isolation will be defined in accordance with COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor. Expenses to be covered by the participant / federation or the medical insurance of each participant.

RESPONSE PROTOCOL IN CASE OF (SUPPOSED) POSITIVITY

In reference to Article 1.3 of the Addendum to IFSC Rules, in case a Team Member feels unwell and/or shows symptoms of acute respiratory infection during the event they shall inform by phone the Technical Delegate (TD) as soon as possible.

APPENDIX I: TRAVEL INFORMATION

Last update information as per 18 February 2021, please check the websites (links below).

Coronavirus ordinances in Switzerland

The two ordinances that are important for you when travelling to Switzerland are: <u>Ordinance 3 on Measures to Combat the Coronavirus (COVID-19) 818.101.24</u> <u>The Ordinance on Measures to Combat the Coronavirus (COVID-19) in International Passenger Transport</u> <u>818.101.27</u>

Register your contact details

Everyone traveling from abroad <u>must register their contact details online</u>. Exceptions are only possible for people living in regions close to the Swiss boarder or from countries/regions that do not have an increased risk of infection if travelling by car (if travelling by plane, bus, train or boat, you must register yourself).

Countries outside of the Schengen area

All participants from countries outside the Schengen area must check if you are one of the countries with an exception. Kindly refer to the <u>list in Annex 1</u> of the <u>Ordinance 3 on Measures to Combat the</u> <u>Coronavirus (COVID-19) 818.101.24</u>, article 3, point 2.

If not, as per article 4, point 2 of the same ordinance, please contact the Swiss embassy in your country to check what you have to do.

In case of **special necessity**, it is possible to enter Switzerland despite the entry ban. Persons who require a visa must apply for one at the Swiss foreign representation where they live, explaining why they are a case of special necessity.

Exceptions are possible for: Entry by professional sportsmen and women and their coaches, etc., in order to participate in competitions or for training camps.

Testing and quarantine for persons arriving from countries and regions with increased risk of infection

Countries and regions with increased risk of infection: <u>Please check this list of countries</u> When arriving from risk countries and/or arriving by plane, a molecular-biological test for Sars-CoV-2 done in the previous 72 hours with a negative result must be mandatory. Details here: <u>Section 4 Testing</u>, <u>Quarantine</u>, and <u>Notification Requirements for Persons entering</u> <u>Switzerland</u>

Exemption from testing and quarantine

The Ordinance on Measures to Combat the Coronavirus in International Passenger Transport 818.101.27 allows under Art. 8, section (C) an exception from the requirement to be tested and to quarantine for persons who for compelling professional reasons enter Switzerland and whose visit cannot be postponed.

The same Art. 8, section (G) states the exemption for participating to a sporting competition.

This applies to all athletes, coaches and medical personnel for the period of their stay for the participation in the IFSC Climbing World Cup in Meiringen.
