RULES, ACCREDITATION & CEREMONIES

COMPETITION RULES

The FISU regulations for World University Championships and the most recent technical regulations of the International Federation of Sport Climbing (IFSC) will be applied in the event and can be found on the respective website. Doping controls during the championship will be organised by FISU and carried out by NADA Austria (National Anti-Doping Agency) in accordance with FISU and IFSC guidelines.

ACCREDITATION

The accreditations for all delegation members can be collected on site by the Head of Delegation. The general period for this can be found in the schedule. There will be a specific time slot for each delegation within this period to pick up their accreditations. The delegations will be informed about their time slot by email prior to the event and via the event website.

To pick up the accreditations, it is required for the Head of Delegation to bring

the original passports of all delegation members. Additionally, it may be necessary to show the eligibility forms of certain delegation members again. If this is the case, the delegation will be informed by FISU a few days before the event.

CEREMONIES

Opening & Closing Ceremonies

We are excited to celebrate the opening and closing ceremonies together with all participants of the event. Therefore, **the attendance of all accredited athletes and officials is required for the opening and closing ceremony**. As part of the Opening Ceremony all delegations will march onto the stage. A rundown of the ceremonies will be communicated at the General Technical Meeting.

Please also note the following:

- Bags and sport equipment are strictly prohibited on stage.
- Marching athletes and delegation officials must wear their official delegation uniform (dressing up is not permitted).
- Banners and additional flags are forbidden (and will be seized). "Thank you" banners are allowed at the Closing Ceremony, but must be submitted to FISU for approval four days prior.
- Only (fully accredited) delegation members can take part in the march-in of the teams.

Medal Ceremonies

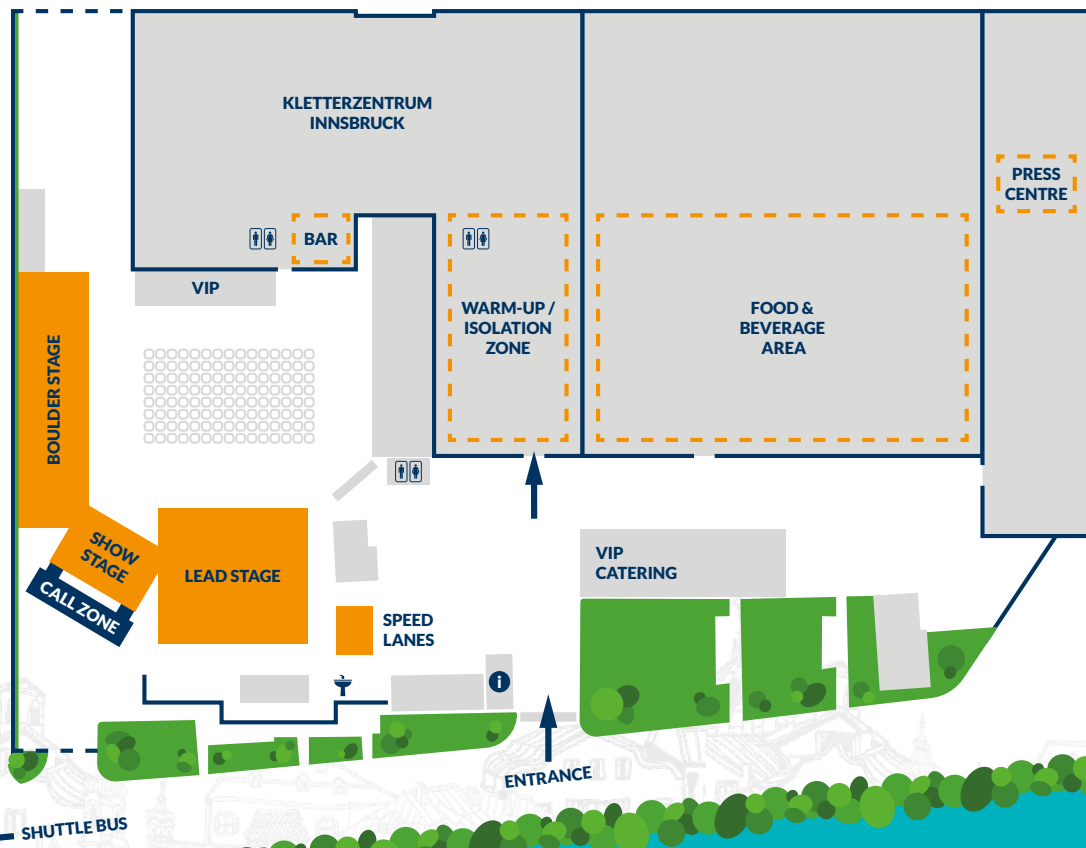
The Medal Ceremonies for all disciplines will take place shortly after the end of the finals. The attendance of all medal winners is mandatory.

Therefore, the cultural programme also represents these two facets of Innsbruck with a choice between two quite contrasting activities.

TIMELINE & GENERAL INFORMATION

ACTIVITY 1: ON TOP OF INNSBRUCK

Wednesday, 15 June | 13:45–16:30 & **Thursday, 16 June** | 14:45–17:30

The first activity consists of a cable car ride to Innsbruck's highest landmark, the Nordkette.

- Meeting point Hungerburgbahn valley station (Innsbruck Congress station, Rennweg 3)
- Ascent to Hungerburg, Seegrube and Hafelekar via cable car
- Hafelekar viewing platform with 360° panoramic view; 10 min walk to second viewing platform with a view of the Karwendel range.
- Lunch on the Seegrube viewing terrace
- Descent from the Seegrube (last gondola: 17:30)

ACTIVITY 2: IMPERIAL PALACE

Tuesday, 14 June | 14:45–16:00 & **Thursday, 16 June** | 15:45–17:00

The second activity consists of a guided tour of the late baroque residence of Empress Maria Theresia on the edge of the old town.

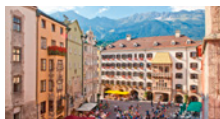

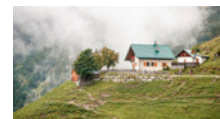

COVID MEASURES

COVID MEASURES

Due to the easing of the epidemiological situation in Austria, most protective measures were already lifted or relaxed. In case this changes and restrictions need to be adapted, this will be communicated to the delegations via mail and on our website.

Travel restrictions to Austria (as of 16 May, 2022)

Entry into Austria is no longer subject to proof, registration or quarantine requirements. The only exception is entry from countries and areas with a very high epidemiological risk. When entering from these states and territories, proof of vaccination / recovery / negative test must be presented, registration must be carried out and a ten-day quarantine must be taken.

Currently, no region is classified as a state or territory with a very high epidemiological risk.

General restrictions in Austria (as of 1 June, 2022)

FFP2 masks are only obligatory in the following vulnerable settings:

- hospitals & medical facilities
- nursing homes
- health services

However, the government may reintroduce the mask requirement if the number of cases increases. Even though FFP2 masks no longer need to be worn everywhere, they are still recommended in all enclosed spaces. A proof of vaccination / recovery / negative test may only be necessary when visiting a hospital or a comparable setting.

Event Restrictions (as of 30 May, 2022)

To ensure the safety of all participants the **Addendum to IFSC Rules** provides Covid-19 guidelines for international sport climbing events. Those regulations will be implemented during the Innsbruck 2022 FISU World University Championship Sport Climbing.

This means accredited persons **must wear a face mask indoors at all times**, except when climbing / exercising. Face masks are also mandatory in our shuttles.
